Transportation Coalition for the 21st Century

The Coalition's Objective

To conduct a data-informed and values-driven, comprehensive review of workable transportation solutions to develop a set of recommendations that outline a coherent, integrated transportation plan capable of achieving six specific goals. The plan should reflect our community values and improve quality of life for commuters, residents and visitors.

SIX COMMUNITY GOALS

1. Substantially reduce or eliminate traffic congestion and allow shorter travel times for residents, visitors and commuters moving throughout the Roaring Fork Valley
2. Focus initially on implementable solutions for the upper valley, including the Entrance to Aspen and Brush Creek, that work equitably for everyone valley-wide
3. Reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 25,000 tons per year, the equivalent of decreasing Castle Creek bridge traffic by 5,000 cars per day. Reduce PM10, PM2.5 and other vehicle pollutants as well
4. Prioritize and incentivize public transit in all its forms
5. Reduce or eliminate rush hour traffic on Cemetery Lane, Smuggler Street, Owl Creek Road, and other streets and roads throughout the system
6. Improve evacuation times and increase safety in all areas that transportation planning can influence
